TOWN OF MARSHALL

BYLAW 03-2008

A Bylaw of the Town of Marshall to control the operation of snowmobiles within the Town Limits.

The Council of the Town of Marshall, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- Subject to the provisions of The Snowmobile Act and Section 2 and Section 3 and Section 4 of 1. this Bylaw, a snowmobile operator may utilize any street, avenue or lane within the Town of Marshall being the most direct route from the operator's residence of the Town limits.
- It shall be lawful to cross with a snow machine on Main Street, Railway Ave. & Old Jasper 2. Highway only at the following intersections;

Main Street and First Avenue, Second Avenue, Third Avenue, Fourth Avenue Old Jasper Highway and 1st St. S.E., 2nd Ave. S.E. & 3rd Ave. S.E. Railway Ave. and 1st St. S.E., 2nd Ave. S.E. and 3rd Ave.S.E.

- No snowmobile shall be operated at a speed greater than 25 kilometers per hour within the 3. limits of the Town of Marshall.
- It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 10:00 P.M.. 4.
- Any person who violates any provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and shall be liable 5. on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$45.00 and costs.
- This Bylaw shall come into force upon receipt of approval from the Highway Traffic Board. 6.

7. Bylaw 3-95 is hereby repealed.
