Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Town of Marshall in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the Council of the Municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Marshall
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service.
3. Council has set the schedule of fees to be the following.

a) Response Fee	as per Saskatchewan Government Insurance Rate
b) Rescue Unit	300.00/hour
c) Fire Engine	350.00/hour
d) Body Job Tanker	150.00/hour
e) Semi Unit Tanker	200.00/hour
f) Ladder	350.00/hour
g) QR Wild Unit	150.00/hour
h) Command Unit	100.00/hour
i) Fire Fighters	25.00/hour
j) Foam A&B	Actual Costs Incurred
k) Additional Contractors	Actual Costs Incurred
4. The Council authorizes the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
5. Bylaw 01-2008 is hereby repealed.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 08 day of May, 2018.
