Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Town of Marshall in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the Council of the Municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Marshall
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service.
- 3. Council has set the schedule of fees to be the following.

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a)	Response Fee	as per Saskatchewan Government Insurance Rate
b)	Rescue Unit	300.00/hour
c)	Fire Engine	350.00/hour
d)	Body Job Tanker	150.00/hour
e)	Semi Unit Tanker	200.00/hour
f)	Ladder	350.00/hour
g)	QR Wild Unit	150.00/hour
h)	Command Unit	100.00/hour
i)	Fire Fighters	25.00/hour
j)	Foam A&B	Actual Costs Incurred

k) Additional Contractors Actual Costs Incurred

- 4. The Council authorizes the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
- 5. Bylaw 01-2008 is hereby repealed.

6. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the 08 day of May, 2018.
