

**TOWN OF MARSHALL
BYLAW NO. 07-2014**


A Bylaw to Establish Property Tax Incentives and Penalties


The Council of the Town of Marshall, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) The following discount schedule will be applied to the municipal portion of the property tax bill in the year in which the fee is levied:
If paid on or before August 31, a 4% discount will be applied
If paid on or before September 30, a 2% discount will be applied
If paid on or before October 31, a 1% discount will be applied
- 2) No discount will apply to the Northwest School Division portion of the property tax bill.
- 3) Property taxes are due on December 31 of each year. A 15% penalty will apply to all outstanding arrears as of January 1 after the annual due date, including the Northwest School Division portion of the property tax bill.
- 4) The penalty charges are to be added to and shall form part of the tax roll.

Bylaw 07-2013 is hereby repealed.
