A BYLAW TO REMOVE ABANDONED VEHICLES ABANDONED VEHICLES

The Council of the Town of Marshall in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. A vehicle is deemed to be abandoned if:
 - (a) the vehicle has been left or placed on a street, public place or land or building owned or controlled by the urban municipality for 10 days or more; and
 - (b) after reasonable inquiry, the owner of the vehicle cannot be ascertained
- 2. The Town of Marshall may recover any fine that remains unpaid, with costs, by seizing and selling any vehicle owned by the person against whom the fine is imposed, wherever the vehicle is found in Saskatchewan.
- 3. The Council may order that a vehicle that is deemed to be abandoned by virtue of Section 371.1, be removed from the place where it is abandoned and sold, destroyed or otherwise disposed of as Council may decide.
- 4. Bylaw 02-2017 is hereby repealed.
