
A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS


The Council of the Town of Marshall, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:


This Bylaw shall be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw"

1. That Section 8 of *The Municipalities Act*, applies only to an infraction of a Bylaw of the Municipality for which no other fine is provided.
2. Subject to the provisions of Section 8, subsection 2(b), any individual found guilty of an infraction of Bylaw of the Municipality, passed by Authority of *The Municipalities Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and the costs for every offence.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 8, subsection 2(c), any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a Bylaw of the Municipality, passed by Authority of *The Municipalities Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$10,000.00 and the costs for every offence.
4. Bylaw 11-95 is hereby repealed.
