
**A BYLAW TO DISPENSE WITH THE PREPARATION OF ASSESSMENT NOTICES**


The Council of the Town of Marshall, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The assessor of the municipality is hereby authorized to dispense with the preparation of assessment notices if the assessed value of a property:
  - (a) has not changed from the previous year's assessed value; or
  - (b) the increase or decrease in assessed value does not exceed the lesser of:
    - (i) \$1,000.00 from the previous year's assessed value; and
    - (ii) 1% of the previous year's assessed value.
2. Bylaw No. 12-1995 is hereby repealed.
