Title: BUSINESS LICENSE ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURE

EFFECTIVE DATE: September 8, 2015

AMENDED:

POLICY STATEMENT:

That an informational letter be sent each January to persons expected to conduct business in the Town of Marshall, stating that a business license must be purchased prior to commencing any work. Further, that a Public Awareness Program be conducted each January through the Town website and newsletters informing residents of the licensing requirements.

That all infractions of the licensing bylaw be handed over to the R.C.M.P. for follow up investigation and subsequent charges when warranted.

PURPOSE:

To allow for strict enforcement of the licensing bylaw and ensure that all persons are treated equally.
