POLICY

Title: Outdoor Watering

EFFECTIVE DATE: October 13, 2015

AMENDED: July 10, 2018

POLICY STATEMENT:

That **Section 5 & 6 of Bylaw No. 06-2016**, which clearly defines how outdoor watering is permitted, be enforced with zero tolerance for non-compliance.

Section 5 & 6 of Bylaw No. 06-2016 shall be enforced using the following procedures:

- 1. All non-compliance must be validated by one of the following persons:
 - i) Member of the R.C.M.P.
 - ii) Town Council Member
 - iii) Any Staff Member
- 2. a) Any person watering outside the permitted days and/or hours shall be sent one warning letter addressed to the property owner within one day of the validated offense.
 - b) Administration shall maintain an updated list of warning letters issued and provide the R.C.M.P. with a copy on a regular basis.
 - c) Second offenses which have been validated shall be reported directly to the R.C.M.P. The R.C.M.P. shall then issue the fine in accordance with Bylaw No. 06-2016.

OTHER:

- Fines are payable at the Town Office.
- Persons noted in Section 1 of this policy must be prepared to provide a statement if required.
- All reports of non-compliance shall be investigated.

PURPOSE:

- To ensure compliance of Water Conservation Practices.
- To decrease abusive consumption of water.
- To ensure an adequate supply of water is sustained for essential use and services.

DEFINITIONS:

1. Permitted Watering (Odd/Even):

- Even numbered houses may water on even numbered calendar dates during the early morning and evening hours.
- Odd numbered houses may water on odd numbered calendar dates during the early morning and evening hours.
- The restrictions above shall remain in force for the months of June, July, August and September.

2. Non-Compliance:

• To avoid watering of lawns, gardens, flower beds or trees with a hose and/or sprinklers during the heat of the day and water conservation practices.
